Major Responsibilities

- Speaking with area businesses to donate necessary food and items for serving and resale on day of the event.
- To acquire all necessary advertisement materials from businesses (who sponsor our event through donations and discounts).
- To coordinate pickup and delivery of all food & supplies for event.
- To supervise and coordinate a schedule of kitchen food service workers for day of event.
- To supervise and coordinate a schedule of kitchen food service workers for clean up for following day of event.
- To provide detailed updates to the Executive Committee as needed.

Qualifications:

- A desire to help your community & those in need!
- Ability to lead... by example.
- Great Communication Skills (written & oral).
- Customer Service Skills
- Transportation (by personal car or bus) if necessary.

Training/Preparation:

- Fundraiser Over-view and On-going support as needed.
- Short history of the Salvation Army.
- Over-view of Programs offered through our local Salvation Army.
- Over-view of the goals & responsibilities of the Women's Auxiliary.

Time/Place:

- 2-4 hours per week as required, additional time is at your discretion.
- Attend monthly Auxiliary meetings.
- Any additional meetings, as it becomes necessary.

Length of Commitment:
