Initiatives Associated with the Mental Health Program

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Fall 2014

- December 2014 – Define roles of “Content Expert” and “Instructional Designer” for course development.
- December 2014 – Seek approval for 150-hour intern from the University of Maine paid through the grant to develop the Mental Health FYE class.
- December 2014 – Design and Implement marketing plan for offering MHT classes statewide – including partnerships with provider agencies who deliver the MHRT/C coursework.
- December 2014 – Identify space at the Alford Campus for the Instructional Design team to work and conduct symposia.
- December 2014 – Cameras with tracking and audio are installed in the Mental Health Classroom in Averill and the new Lecture Hall.
- December 2014 - Purchase 1 Adobe Cloud subscriptions for Instructional Designers.

Spring 2015

- January 2015 - Define job description for the Program Coordinator.
- January 2015 – Seek and establish partnership to offer a Bachelors of Social Work on the Alford Campus (Implement by Fall 2015).
- January 2015 – Install Apple TV devices into Mental Health and Social Sciences classrooms on both the Fairfield and Alford campuses.

 - Version 2 is a basic course on Introduction to Social Services for online delivery.
 - Prepare to deliver both courses each semester (Fall, Spring, and Summer)
