Developing Service Goals / Plans

At a fundamental level, as case managers, all of our actions are dictated and directed by the "Service Plan". On p. 339-340 of your textbook you have 5 brief case studies reflecting people at different stages of recovery. You will do a brief write-up on each of these individuals including the following components:

For each "client":

- Name
- Brief history of situation (copy from the book)
- Measurable goal that meets both the "Dead Man" and "Stranger" tests
 - o Goal includes Who / What / When / Where

Make sure you have a title page.

Do not use I, we, or you. Essay should be submitted in a word processing document. This can be saved as a .doc, .docx, or .rtf file.

The essay will be graded using the following rubric:
