The Homeless Services Case Manager manages a caseload of clients who are homeless or at risk of homelessness, diagnosed with emotional disturbance, behavioral disorder, mental illness or pervasive developmental disorder. The Case Manager provides community integration services including skills development and daily living support services or targeted case management services to clients who meet eligibility requirements. Services include intake and assessment, individual service, crisis and support planning, coordination and advocacy through planning and linking clients with resources, monitoring and evaluation. The Homeless Services Case Manager provides a range of on-site and community based services including admission, supervision and ongoing support to clients in our emergency shelter locations and permanent housing programs. This position will establish trusting relationships and act as a resource linking clients with community services. This role provides direct services with a goal of teaching clients to develop independent living skills and the skills needed for self-sufficiency and providing groups and offering activities to program participants. These groups and activities may be scheduled on the weekends. The Homeless Services Case Manager will work variable hours including occasional weekends based on client needs and be available for on-call rotation for all homeless services.
