Mechanics Checklist

Use this checklist to ensure that your assignment is submitted using good mechanics

Spelling

Read through your paper out loud to catch common spelling errors.

Please use spell- and grammar-check prior to submitting your assignment (this applies to all aspects of this project).

Punctuation

Check through to be sure you use the correct punctuation.

Check for the appropriate use of commas.

Sentence Structure

Check that your sentences are all in the same "person." This refers to the both the removal of the personal perspective (avoid using "I" or "we") and tense (when you are reporting on research you want to consistently use the past tense "Smith and Roberts reported..." or present tense "Smith and Roberts report..."

Word Choice

Ensure that you do not use the same common words all the time. This makes your paper tedious to the reader.

Use Times New Roman 12 pt. font. No use of bold, italics, underlined, or alternative fonts.

The entire document is double spaced.

Please do **not** use contractions (e.g., don't).
